

Lead Professional: Collaboration

The Trustees wish to award a fixed term payment (TLR 3) to a member of staff who will be responsible for leading collaboration projects across the Trust. - To provide an early proposal to CAT Executive regarding collaborative projects for the academic year
- To provide an end of year evaluative report to the Board of Trustees reviewing the success of collaborative projects (max. 2 side of A4)
- To manage communications regarding collaborative projects across the Trust to maximise the effectiveness and impact of the projects
- Implement and manage an effective budget for each project
- Effectively manage the time allocation to maximise collaboration in Cheshire Academies Trust
